



HOW TO: CLEAN YOUR SPA

To clean the **spa shell**, use a mild non-abrasive, non-sudsing cleaner (we recommend Off the Wall, which can be used while water is still in the spa) and a soft rag or nylon scrubber to remove dirt build-up. The spa pillows can be removed and cleaned by following the instructions in your Owner's Manual.

To clean the **hot tub vinyl cover**, follow this step-by-step method: first, remove the cover and spray it lightly with a garden hose to loosen any dirt or debris that might have accumulated. Using a mild soap solution (1 teaspoon dishwashing liquid with 2 gallons water) or baking soda, scrub the vinyl in a circular motion with a large sponge. Promptly rinse with a garden hose. Rinse the bottom of the cover (do not use soap), and wipe it clean with a dry rag.

Helpful Hints: Showering without soap prior to entering the spa, and using only the rinse cycle when laundering your bathing suit will help avoid detergent and soap residue in the spa water.

Also, remember to drain your spa water and refill every 3 months if you use your spa weekly, and every 5 months if you use your spa less than once a week. Replacing spa water eliminates detergent residue from bathing suits and soap film which usually begins accumulating in the spa water.
